

NEW MOON SOLAR ECLIPSE TODAY

We are entering a two-week double eclipse period with a solar eclipse and a partial lunar eclipse two weeks down the road. I have written about eclipse and their potential visions many times, so I am not going to repeat myself much here. Just remember that these times are (relatively speaking) very intense times, astrologically. The Tibetan Buddhists make it very clear that at New and Full Moons in general, but especially at the times of eclipses, the central channel and inner winds (spine area) just naturally come into alignment, WHETHER WE KNOW IT OR NOT.

Anyway, the flavor of this particular New Moon eclipse IMO is one of equanimity, very balanced and stable on the outside persona, with not too much push or drive to do anything extra. Things are rolling smoothly along on the exterior.

On the inner life, however, there is plenty of drive or desire to accomplish something, who knows what? It could be just to get out and mingle, meet, travel, see the world, or to do something different. My point is that while the outside is calm, the inner part of us is very much active, and looking to experience something new to take the horn off our inner itch.

Also togetherness or even spirituality (whatever you call it) may be a little easier just now and we could even be moved to look into our spiritual path or direction more than we normally would.

Summary: Outside smooth and balanced, inside taught and driven to do 'something'. The flavor of this eclipse is more spiritual in nature and we may even find more of our inner path through this.
