Just a heads-up on a couple of new projects I am involved in. I have been approached by "The Stage Couch TV," produced by Ryan Williams, to air "Friends of the Sixties," a series of half-hour TV segments on the 1960s, probably focusing a lot on music from that era. In addition, I will be producing a second series called "Astrologyland TV," where I will cover things like I do in my blogs here, solar flares, eclipses, and various astrology and spiritual themes.

The series will appear in over 500,000 hotel rooms, business centers, time-share locations, and college campuses across the country via proprietary in-room channels, where the content will be available on-demand, 24x7, and also on Wi-Fi.
